## Course Overview

The England Ice Hockey **Level 2 Coaching Course** is designed to develop confident, capable coaches who can independently lead high-quality training sessions and mentor developing Level 1 coaches.

Upon successful completion, Level 2 Coaches will be able to:

- Deliver structured and progressive coaching sessions
- Lead activities safely and effectively
- Plan and implement session plans to meet player needs
- Support and guide Level 1 coaches within their club

Participants will be granted **temporary Level 2 status** following completion of the course. **All online modules** must be completed before attending, and certificates will need to be uploaded in advance. Participants will be granted temporary Level 1 status once they've completed the course and will then be required to submit a **written knowledge assessment**.

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## Equipment & Safety Requirements

- All participants **must wear an approved ice hockey helmet** during the on-ice session.
- Participants **under 18** must wear a **full-face cage**.
- Attendance at **all sessions** (classroom and on-ice) is compulsory.
- All attendees must be able to demonstrate effective communication skills in English (listening, speaking, reading, writing, and comprehension).
- Consumption of alcohol **before or during** the course is strictly prohibited and may result in removal from the workshop.

## Course Prerequisites

To attend the in-person Level 2 Coaching Course, participants must:

- Be **18 years of age or older** on the first day of the course
- Have been **accepted onto the acceleration programme**
- Submit a **completed Level 1 coaching portfolio** to [peter.winn@englandicehockey.com](mailto:peter.winn@englandicehockey.com)
- Have logged **at least 50 hours of coaching**, verified and signed off by their Club Team Coach
- Maintain their status and registration as an **EIH Level 1 Coach** or **Temporary Level 2 Coach**

Participants should also possess a strong working knowledge of:

- The game of ice hockey
  - Rules and officiating principles
  - Coaching terminology and core concepts
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## Cancellation Policy
